

The Terraces

The Terraces is a charming miner's cottage set amidst a lovely old-fashioned cottage garden.

It's perched high on a large elevated block so has magnificent sweeping views of the town and surrounding mountains.

Although only a short walk to the Main Street Shops, the swimming pool and recreation ground, up at *The Terraces* you feel so far away.

The Terraces offers a sense of tranquillity and space.

Maldon

Maldon is a small country town that was once a thriving gold rush town and has remained virtually unchanged since the 19th century. After the decline of gold the town was ignored by developers because it was 'off the beaten track'.

In 1966 the National Trust declared Maldon to be Victoria's first 'Notable Town'.

For the visitor, Maldon offers many things:

- * craft and antique shops
- * restaurants
- * historic town walks
- * bushwalks
- * steam train rides
- * horse and carriage rides
- * scenic drives
- * restored mine sites and Carmen's Tunnel tour
- * swimming, boating and fishing at nearby Lake Cairn Curran.

Maldon is only an hour and a half from Melbourne. Follow the Calder Highway until the Castlemaine/Maldon turnoff. There's a huge sign. If you miss it, keep going through Harcourt to the Maldon turnoff.

On wintry nights sit around the open fire in the cosy lounge room.

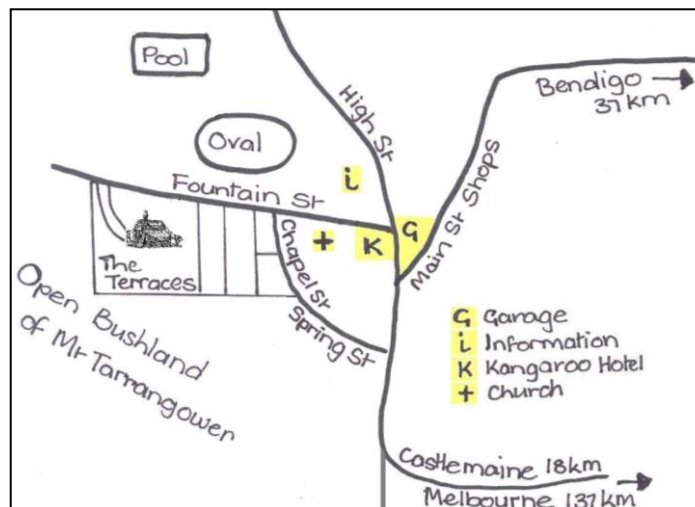
On sunny days, lunch outside under the old Peppercorn tree shading the side terrace or on the large enclosed verandah behind *The Terraces*.

Wander around the garden and enjoy the rose arches, fruit trees and herb garden. For solitude you can retreat into the canopy of the huge Morton Bay Fig tree behind the cottage or just walk through the back gate into the bushland of Mt Tarrangower where there are extensive walking tracks.

An album with maps and information about local attractions and places to visit is in the cottage. The tourist office is at the bottom of the street, in High Street.

DIRECTIONS TO *The Terraces*

It's easy to get to *The Terraces*. Once you get to Maldon, find the Kangaroo Hotel at the junction of Main and High Streets. The Kangaroo Hotel is on the corner of Fountain Street.



Drive up Fountain Street and look for the cottage on the hill with a sign saying '*The Terraces*'. The sign is on the arch at the front gate.

If you are arriving at night the caretakers leave on the back light.

The Terraces is fully self contained. You only need to take **sheets, pillow cases, towels and a bathmat** (unless linen is booked). In *The Terraces* you will find:

- * **kitchen** is fully equipped (electric stove). Teatowels are provided.
- * **lounge room** has an open fireplace and a reverse cycle heater/cooler. The woodshed is behind the sheds.
- * **sunroom** has a comfortable sitting area (two couches and a coffee table) and a dining area.
- * **bedrooms** have pillows and quilts provided. One bedroom has two single beds, the other a double bed.
- * **bathroom** has a walk in shower. There is a washing machine.
- * **barbecue** has outside lighting. The switch is near the shed door.
- * **veranda** at the back is large, sheltered and wire screened.
